WATER CONSUMPTION REPORT

The Board of Directors is pleased to announce that our Water Consumption is back on track. Each unit had been checked for toilets that were running continuously as well as taps. All problems have been rectified and our average water consumption as of August 31, 2014 is at \$69.24 per unit.

THERMAL PANES

The Condo recently had to replace a thermal pane in one of the units. This is just to advise you that when there is any replacement of windows to individual units the cost is shared between the home owner and the condo unless negligence is proven.

HOME OWNERS INSURANCE

Please review your policy especially in regards to the deductible. Ensure that policy will cover the condo deductible (\$5,000.00 +).

SMOKE DETECTORS

This is fire prevention month. Please check your fire alarms so that your family is safe. Anyone who has not returned the signed Owners Certification of compliance with provision of the Fire Code Part IV with respect to smoke detectors/alarms please do so as soon as possible.

Carbon Monoxide Detectors

Carbon monoxide detectors became law in Ontario, as the Bill was passed unanimously on November 27, 2013. Once the law has been enacted, it will be mandatory to have one installed in each unit. Location for the detectors should be located close to where you sleep.

FURNACES

Please ensure that your furnace is serviced. This action can save lives as well as save you money. If you still the original furnace make sure that you have it checked for cracked heat exchanger.
